
SPECTACLED THIRUSH



Spectacled thrushes eat a variety of fruits, berries and insects. Young hatchlings are fed worms which are a good source of protein

These thrushes make their nests in the crooks of tree branches using mud, twigs and other plant materials and females lay 2-4 bluish-green eggs with reddish speckles 1-2 times a year
